- Go to Abair Liom D Book on www.folensonline.ie
- Click on "Resources" tab.
- Scroll down for "Postaer- An Phicnic"
- There are seven little pictures, which are the activities to build up the vocabulary. Sound is required for these activities.

- Click on Foclóir 1 icon and click the play button at the end of the screen to play the game. Try repeating the words out loud! When you are finished the game, click on the little home icon at the bottom to bring you back to all the activities!
- Click on Foclóir 2 and try this game. When you are finished, click the home icon again!
- Click on "Scéal" and listen the story about the picnic. Try reading along with the story! You can click play any amount of times to get used to the new vocabulary and pronunciation. Try reading along out loud with the girl's voice. Then click on the home icon.
- Now try the "Ceisteanna" game. These are questions based on the story. To hear the different responses, click on the headphones icon.
   To choose a response, click on the sentence! Once finished, click on the home button.
- Now click on "Amhráin". This is a song called "Mo bhosca lóin" (my lunch box). Listen and join in with the words on screen. Listen a few times. Click back using the home icon again.
- Lastly click on the "Dán" icon. This is a poem. It's called "Ispíní" (Sausages). It's about a dog, who walks into the kitchen and steals three sausages. Join in with the rap style poem.

- Turn over the page to page 12. This is a "Rólimirt" or a role-play. Read the role-play first 2 or 3 times. Then the child could act it out with a parent/another child in the house
