# Hello Everyone,

This is a suggested learning plan for the week starting Monday 30th March. You can use as much or as little of it as you want. Do not put yourself under pressure. When we are back to school, we will pick up where we left off. No child will be left behind! School books may follow in due course. Please keep an eye on the school website and Aladdin Connect.

# <u>Literacy:</u>

- Phonics recap 'ar' and 'er'
- Songs Youtube link for sounds
- Make a list of words that have these sounds (march, car, arm, star, garden, calf, mixer, ginger, summer, mother, weather, water, tiger, spider)
- Word family 'od' (can your write some words from this word family? Sound them out and give yourself a test) nod, pod, rod, God, cod, plod
- Read story of Jack and the Beanstalk Link to story here
- Play 'I Spy' with the words from the story of Jack and the Beanstalk Game link here
- Can you sequence the story? What happened first/ next/ last?
- Practise writing your capital and small letters (Cc, Ll, Oo, Pp, Ss, Uu, Vv, Ww, Xx, Yy, Zz)
- Read a storybook from home.
- Giraffe words.
- Sounds revision (letters).
- You can access 'Sounds Like Phonics' online at Fallons no password requires. Click on Activity Book B - Unit 1 'The Park'.

# Numeracy:

- Practise writing letters 0- 9, you could try rainbow colours.
- Count from 0 to 20 and from 20 to 0.
- Counting song (Count to 20 and Workout Jack Hartmann) <u>Youtube Count with Jack</u>
- 3-D shapes revision (*cube, cuboid, sphere and cylinder*) look for these shapes in your home.
- 3-D shape powerpoint 3-D Powerpoint
- 3-D shape riddles eg. I have six faces. I cannot roll on the floor. What shape am I? (cube)
- Feely bag put a shape into a bag. The child puts their hand in but does not look. They have to guess the shape by feeling it.
- Pick a shape eg. *cuboid* (*box of cereal*), draw around each of it's faces, what do you notice about the shape of each face?
- 3-D shapes song '3-D Shapes I know' Shape Song link
