

<p>Literacy / SPHE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phonics – recap ue and ou sounds (perhaps focus on a different sound a day – Monday ‘ue’ Tuesday ou etc.) Songs https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=SNEuPO5CbXA Make a list of words that have these sounds (que, clue, blue, glue, statue, barbecue, fuel, out, our, shout, loud, mouth, cloud, house, round, sound) Write some of these words on a piece of paper and then call out a word and get your child to find the word and colour it in. Sounds Like Phonics’ online https://www.slp.cjfallon.ie – no password required. Click on Activity Book B – Unit 1 The Park to revise vowel diagraphs. Word family – ot (can you write some words from this word family? Sound them out and give yourself a test) got, rot, dot, lot, spot. 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<p>Numeracy</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise writing letters 0-9 – you could try rainbow colours Oral Maths - Practise counting forwards/ backwards to 10. Revise the story of 10: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Count various items in groups of 10, e.g. 10 teddies, 10 spoons etc. Ask what number comes before/after 10. Construct the ‘story of 10’ using the fingers on both hands. Ask the children to hold up 2/3/4/ fingers. How many more fingers must be added to make 10? Answer first, then check by counting remaining fingers. Point to a number between 1–10 on the number line (number line in your child’s homework folder). For example, point to 3 on the number line. Check which number must be added to 3 in order to make 10 by ‘jumping on’ on the number line. Repeat several times, starting with a different number each time.
