Simple ideas for your

Monday-

Give your child 12 items (could be grapes, little pieces of paper, cheerios, lego pieces, coins, pegs), they must share out these items with you. Encourage your child to count the items before they start and then count how many they get when they have been shared. You then demonstrate saying '6 is half of 12', they then repeat this. Repeat this activity using different amounts of items.

Tuesday-

Give your child a square shape paper towel, tissue or piece of paper. Ask them to fold it into 4 equal parts. Ask them how many ways they can make quarters.

Wednesday-

Give you child various size containers to fill with water/flour/sand so they're roughly one quarter full.

Thursday-

Give your child playdough if you have some, encourage you child to make shapes and to cut them into halves and quarters.
