# Subject Specific Tasks:

### Literacy

This week we are going to continue to explore **procedural writing**. We are going to continue looking at explaining how to do things rather than making things! Remember, your instructions need to be simple and very clear.

- Day One: Revision of procedural writing & interview activity.

- Day Three: Frozen hair tutorial & evaluation activity.
- Day Four: Drawing activities.
- Day Four: Time to write How to wash/dry/style your hair.

As well as exploring procedural writing, we are going to be exploring **visualisation** again this week. This is a very important reading comprehension strategy, it allows us to explore more than the words in the text, visualising allows us to create pictures in our minds to go with the words, it helps us immerse ourselves into the world of the book and gets us into the mind of the characters. #### Numeracy
