**English-** Reading and comprehension activity based on the story 'The Cowboy Hat' from our book *Wordwise* (**Activity will be available on Seesaw from 6<sup>th</sup> May**)

**Gaeilge** - Our new theme is Sa Bhaile (at home)

Look at this 'Bí ag Léamh' sheet and listen to the words being read (*Seesaw*)

Play the audio again, pause it and say each sentence after me.

Now, try to read the sentences by yourself (remember í makes 'ee' sound á makes 'aw' sound, é makes 'ay' sound)

Record an audio clip of yourself reading all of the sentences and send it to me on *Seesaw*
