This is an aquarium in Monterey in America, they have loads of live cameras on different animals, so you can look in and see what they're up to – there are penguins, otters, sharks, jelly fish and a few others too. Because it's on American time instead of Irish time most of the cameras aren't live until 2pm our time so you might have to wait until after then to have a look in but they're definitely worth a look! Depending on the time you check in you might be lucky and see the penguins being fed or the sea otters being trained. If you see anything interesting be sure to let us know! 😊
