### **Monday 8<sup>th</sup>**

**English In Practice** – Day 129 page 66

**English** – Wordwise page 44 Phonics (Activity will be available on Seesaw Monday morning)

**Maths** – This week we will be learning about *addition*.

Lesson 1 start by practising counting in 10's as fast as you can all the way to 100, maybe try counting backwards in 10's too. Then complete B and C on page 112 in Planet Maths.

**Number Facts** – '+7' page 46 Monday. Remember to use Twistables or Crayons to help you count. You could also draw a 10 frame and colour in the dots if that helps.

**SESE** – Geography Under The Stones Window on The World page 76 and 77. (Activity will be available on Seesaw)

**Art** – Can be done between now and Friday. Linking with Under The Stones lesson in Geography. The lesson is explained more on Seesaw. When you are out for a walk this week or playing in your garden, gather nature items such as leaves, twigs, stones, wild flowers etc. Next, use what you have found to design an insect - it could be a worm, earwig or centipede that we are learning about this week or another insect. You could make your design on sheet of paper, piece of card or a paper plate.

## Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup>

**English In Practice** - Day 130 page 66

**Maths** - This week we will be learning about *addition*.

Lesson 2 just like yesterday but this time practise counting in 2's up to 20 and in 5's up to 50. Then complete page 113 in Planet Maths.

**Number Facts** - '+7' page 46 Tuesday. Remember to use Twistables or Crayons to help you count. You could also draw a 10 frame and colour in the dots if that helps.

**English**- Wordwise Capital I page 45. Activity on Seesaw.

**Grow In Love** - page 36, colour in the letters that have a dot in them and write it neatly in the box, and page 37, unscramble the words to read the prayer before Communion.

## Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>

**English In Practice** - Day 131 page 67

**English**- Seesaw comprehension activity based on Hide and Seek in our Wordwise book page 74 and 75.

**Maths** - This week we will be learning about *addition*

Lesson 3 Planet Maths page 119. Use the 100 square to help you. Remember when adding on 10 it is one jump down on the 100 square, adding on 20 is 2 jumps down, adding 30 is 3 jumps down and adding 40 is 4 jumps down.

**Number Facts** - '+7' page 47 Wednesday. Remember to use Twistables or Crayons to help you count. You could also draw a 10 frame and colour in the dots if that helps.

**Grow In Love-** page 38, match the words to complete the sentences and fill in the speech bubbles, and page 39, fill in the blanks and read the prayer after Communion.

**Maths** - Planet Maths page 69.
