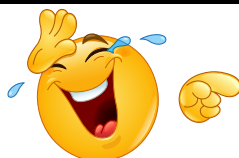
Remember to send back in the empty plastic lunch boxes every day. Thursdays @ 5pm is the last chance to change your order for the following week.
